## By Law 21 (h) - Use of extra players in Finals

Notwithstanding any other provision of the By-Laws, in Junior Finals a team may use an eligible registered team member in a direct substitution of one (1) player in the doubles set in Open Rubbers Format. The player not substituted must remain in their player position.


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## By Law 21 (h) - Use of extra players in Finals

Notwithstanding any other provision of the By-Laws, in Junior Finals a team may use an eligible registered team member in a direct substitution of up to two (2) players in the last two (2) doubles sets in Open Singles Doubles Format. The players not substituted must remain in their player positions.

## An Example:

In JOSD you can take the number one (1) listed player on the card out of their last doubles set and substitute the 5th team member in their place. The other players continue playing to the order they are listed on the card. Note: you DO NOT move the players around, it is a direct substitution (take a player out, put another eligible player in their place, like when there is an injury).

## If the match is DRAWN - Appendix H ( $\mathbf{1 g}$ )

In the event of a drawn finals match for Juniors and Seniors ( with the exception of the JDC format), a ten point advantage tie-breaker will be played by the last doubles pair named on the scorecard.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the By-Laws, in Junior Finals a team may use an eligible registered team member in a direct substitution of up to two (2) players in the last two (2) doubles sets in Open Doubles Format. The players not substituted must remain in their player positions.

Note: you DO NOT move the players around, it is a direct substitution (take a player out, put another eligible player in their place, like when there is an injury).

## If the match is DRAWN - Appendix H (1g)

In the event of a drawn finals match for Juniors and Seniors ( with the exception of the JDC format), a ten point advantage tie-breaker will be played by the last doubles pair named on the scorecard.
